Responsibly and securely recycle your outdated electronics with monthly collection on the last Friday of the month at The Good Samaritan Thrift Store parking area.



Collections are 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. at 3067 N Montana Avenue on:

November 30th* *December 28th* *January 25th

February 22nd* *March 29th* *April 26th

Items accepted at no charge (\$10 donation to Good Samaritan suggested):

Computer towers, laptops, adapters, keyboards, mice, speakers, docking stations, printers, scanners, and backup power supplies; telephones, fax machines, routers, switches, and cords; stereos, speakers, gaming systems, remote controls, and cords; LCD Monitors and Televisions (up to 36 inches); and cell phones, tablets, iPods, like items and accessories.

Charges apply for: Cathode ray tube (CRT), console, and projection televisions (\$1 per diagonal inch); Data Destruction Receipts (\$3 by email, \$4 by mail); Other televisions or monitors 37 inches or larger (\$15 per item); and Clean microwaves with glass tray removed (\$15 per unit). *Please call ahead if with a business or institution.*

Not Accepted: Batteries (except those included in the recycled items; and laptop and cell phones batteries), large and kitchen (except microwaves), and biohazard items.
